6. *New Business/Upcoming Events-*

- a. Half Court (Asphalt): Dr. Cheri Long mentioned that the district has purchased adjustable basketball goals for all the schools; however, RCE needs a place to put these goals. She is asking the PTO to fund a 60x50 asphalt basketball court for the RCE playground in the amount of \$10,000.00.
- b. Easter Eggs & Baskets: Kayla Arnold has requested that PTO provide Easter eggs and baskets for kindergarten. How many eggs? How many baskets? When are they needed? Parents were asked to donate Easter eggs and sealed candy in the past, is this something that parents could purchase?
- c. Standard Fridge: Angie Brown has asked PTO to provide a fridge for the second teacher work room. Could we find a used one at a reasonable price? If not, how much would PTO want to chip in for the purchase of a third standard fridge?
- d. Career Fair Lunch: Mary Lipford would like PTO to consider covering lunch for the exhibitors and their helpers for Roan Creek Elementary's Career Fair in May 2023. Suggestions on food – subway would run about \$7.00 per person. The food truck used by Doe Elementary last year charged \$6.00 per person. Or we could offer pizza? Approx number amount?
- e. Sixth Grade Farewell Dance: Every year Roan Creek Elementary tries to do something special for our graduating sixth grade students, to say goodbye as they transition to Johnson County Middle School. Dr. Cheri Long has suggested a dance this year. Would PTO like to host this as a free event for the sixth grade?
